



Parent Notification Letter for School Improvement

October 3, 2016

Dear Parents,

Embedded in Section 1116 of NCLB are the requirements for LEAs with schools identified for improvement in academic skills, as identified by state test results, to set aside Title I funds for public school choice to be implemented in the 2016-2017 school year. LEAs were required to notify parents of students at such schools of the option to transfer to another school within the LEA that was not identified for improvement.

Academy with Community Partners, here by known as the Legal Education Agency (LEA), is required to notify all parents of students enrolled that ACP students scored in the bottom 25% on state testing in Reading, based upon previous state testing results. This parent letter hereby serves as parental notice of the school needing improvement in state test results in Reading in order to meet state requirements.

ACP is a stand-alone charter school, and there are no other schools associated with ACP, that can be used for transferring students. Parents have the option of transferring their children to other public / charter schools as provided for through NCLB regulations, under the provisions of "public school choice options" under Section 1116 of NCLB. However, ACP will not be responsible for transportation costs to another school, according to regulations regarding stand-alone schools.
